NOTE: Yearbooks are scheduled to arrive in mid-May. Our goal is to get them to you in the May 15 Learning Packet Exchange.

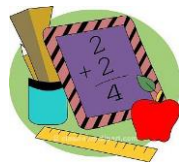


3rd Grade Memorial Day Program
