PROGRAM OFFERS

- Certified teachers in the area of Early Childhood Education.
- A Play-based curriculum, which supports children’s learning in all areas of development.
- A qualified team of specialists to support the learning and development of children.
- Small classes licensed by the Ohio Department of Education.
- A commitment to strengthening the partnership between parents and schools.
- The inclusion of children as “typical peers” to model age-appropriate skills

PROGRAM PROVIDES

- 5 star Step Up to Quality Rated Program.
- Enriching environment for all children ages 3 to 5 years old.
- Respect for each child’s unique and individual qualities.
- Center-based, developmentally appropriate activities.
- Monthly Family Involvement.
- Milk daily as part of a snack.

CLASSES

Monday through Thursday each week, plus the first Friday of every month.

The AM class meets 8:00am - 11:10am. The PM class meets 11:50am - 3:00pm.

ENROLLMENT PROCESS

1. **Referral** - Any parent or agency may make a referral by calling PEVS schools.
2. **PS Screening** - Trained personnel gather information through observation and screening to determine the need for further evaluation.
3. **Evaluation** - **IF** the screening reveals concerns, a multifaceted evaluation may be conducted by a team of educators, including the parent, to determine if a disability exists. **IF** there are no concerns, the child may be registered as a typical student.
4. **Individualized Education Plan** - **IF** the child is eligible as a preschooler with a disability, an educational plan will be developed by the team to address the child’s needs.
5. **Registration** - Parents must complete Final Forms online and provide required documentation.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS TO BRING

- Proof of Residency
- Birth Certificate
- Immunization Record
- Social Security Number
- Custody Documents (If applicable)
- The physical form must be completed & submitted thirty days from the start date

TRANSPORTATION

Bussing may be available depending on the location of the child’s residence in the PEVS school district.

TUITION

There is a monthly tuition fee for typical students. Free or reduced tuition is available to families who qualify based on income and the Federal Poverty Guidelines. A financial application and proof of income must be submitted.

Children with an IEP do not pay tuition and will receive needed services free of charge.
